Some of these children come from a certain neighborhood school to participate in programs at our center. Our staff picks up these children at the end of the school day and either walks or buses with them back to our center. Other students at our organization are brought to our center by their parents from other schools. Can the funding for "After school programming for low income Mission youth" be applied to services for all of these children - both those that receive services and transportation as well as those that just receive services - or will the funding only apply to the former group?</p>	<p>Funds distributed through the Community Grants RFP will support programs offered in the prescribed district. All youth participating in the program are eligible for services funded through the RFP.</p>
