<b>Healthy Eating Programing</b>	<b>Community cooking program</b>	For the Healthy Eating Programming/Community Cooking grant, is there a specific age range you are targeting?	There are no RFP requirements for the age range to be served by the program. DCYF supports programs serving children and youth age 0 to 24.
<b>Healthy Eating Programing</b>	<b>Community cooking program</b>	For the District 5, Healthy Eating Programming/community cooking grant, how specific is the target population the program is looking to support? For example, would a program that serves youth only be eligible? Or is the program intended to support programs that reach a broader Western Addition population - for example, a program that provides cooking activities for both youth and their families?
